

# 2022 STATISTICS & NOTEWORTHY CALLS FOR SERVICE

For the Co-Responding Mental Health Professional

## 344 Co-Response Calls with Officer & MHP

For the last four years the Co-Response Unit has worked diligently with an aging Redmond resident. The resident struggles with a significant mental health issue resulting in an involuntary inpatient treatment. The condition of the home became unlivable. The Co-Response Unit and MHP worked with social services, attorneys, the Designated Crisis Responders, Mobile Integrated Health & Involuntary Treatment Act (ITA) Court to secure formal guardianship, a new supportive living location, and the rehabilitation of the home.

The Co-Response Unit worked with Redmond Detectives to address the significant threats made to a local business from a Redmond resident. The resident had access to firearms (via another party), which they were not legally allowed to possess themselves. The Resident had significant mental health and substance abuse issues combined with life safety threats being made by them. The Co-Response Unit was able to coordinate efforts with Detectives to remove the firearms, apply for an Extreme Risk Protection Order (ERPO), and safety plan with the families and community members under threat. Further, the resident was able to obtain stabilization treatment for the mental health and substance abuse issues co-currently.

A Redmond resident with significant mental health issues and acute suicidality has been working with the Co-Response Unit for a couple of years. The situation became so acute that the resident had to surrender any firearms to law enforcement. The resident hid one in a local park without informing the police. A family member of the resident called the Co-Responding MHP for help as the resident was in a local park with them threatening to kill themselves with the hidden firearm. The Co-Responding MHP and a Negotiator from North Sound Metro Hostage Negotiation Team were able to successfully talk the resident into surrendering. The resident was transported to the ER and the firearm was secured.
