**REDMOND CITY COUNCIL
ORDINANCE NO. _____**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, REPEALING AND RE-ADOPTING THE
2024-2050 TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES PLAN IN
ORDER TO CORRECT INADVERTENT OMISSIONS,
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND ESTABLISHING
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Growth Management Act (GMA) requires that
comprehensive plans and development regulations shall be subject
to continuing evaluation and review; and

WHEREAS, the GMA requires that Redmond complete a
periodic update of its comprehensive plan by December 31, 2024;
and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond adopted Ord. No. 3181 on
November 19, 2024 to fulfill GMA periodic update requirements;
and,

WHEREAS, the 2024-2050 Transportation Facilities Plan
was adopted as part of Ord. No. 3181; and

WHEREAS, some pages of the 2024-2050 Transportation
Facilities Plan were inadvertently omitted from Ord. No. 3181;
and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to repeal the incomplete plan and replace it with a complete 2024-2050 Transportation Facilities Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Classification.** This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. **Findings and Conclusions.** The City Council hereby adopts the findings and conclusions found in Ord. No. 3181.

Section 3. **Transportation Facilities Plan Repealed.**
The Transportation Facilities Plan adopted as Appendix G to the Transportation Element of the Redmond Comprehensive Plan in Ord. No. 3181 is repealed.

Section 4. **Transportation Facilities Plan Adopted.** The Transportation Facilities Plan as shown in Exhibit 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full, is adopted as Appendix G to the Transportation Element of the Redmond Comprehensive Plan.

Section 5. Preparation of Final Transportation

Facilities Plan Document. The Administration is directed to complete preparation of the final Transportation Facilities Plan document, including correction of any typographical errors; minor editorial revisions; inclusion of appropriate graphics and illustrations; and general formatting.

Section 6. Severability. If any section, sentence,

clause, or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 7. Effective date. This ordinance shall become

effective five days after its publication, or publication of a summary thereof, in the City's official newspaper, or as otherwise provided by law.
