Redmond Climate Commitment Act-Funded Projects

Redmond has been awarded a total of \$2,219,000 in grants funded by CCA dollars. \$1,000,000 of the awarded dollars are contingent on the outcome of I-2117 in November. A summary of the grants awarded is outlined below:

Transportation

- \$250,000 for electric fire engine charging infrastructure (*contingent on the CCA vote in November*). Funding from the <u>WA supplemental transportation budget.</u>
- \$750,000 appropriated for this biennium (contingent on CCA vote in November) for the 148th Ave NE Bicycle and Pedestrian Overpass Project from Move Ahead Washington. \$8M total award.

Energy

- \$3.1M award to Energy Smart Eastside (split between 6 cities \$297K to Redmond) from the <u>Department of Commerce Home Electrification and</u> Appliance Rebates Program
- \$850K award from Puget Sound Energy for Energy Smart Eastside Boost Program (split between 5 cities \$187K to Redmond). These are pass through CCA funds.
- \$1.5M award (not announced) to Energy Smart Eastside (split between 6 cities -\$285K to Redmond) from the <u>Department of Commerce Adult Family Homes</u> <u>Home Electrification and Appliance Rebate Program</u>
- \$100,000 for solar and energy storage feasibility study from the <u>Department of</u> <u>Commerce Solar Plus Storage Program</u>

• Climate Resilience and Mitigation Planning

• \$350,000 for HB 1181 implementation from the <u>Department of Commerce</u> <u>Climate Planning Grant Program</u>
