




Conceptual Site Plan


Floor Plan – Level 1

Soft Cost Total	\$10.4M
Project Contingency (5% of all costs)	\$2.0M
Structural Analysis and Demolition of previous Senior Center	\$0.3M
1% for Arts	\$0.3M
Furnishings	\$0.8M
Permits and Impact Fees	\$1.0M
Construction Management	\$1.6M
Architecture and Engineering	\$4.4M
