OVERVIEW STATEMENT:

Ian Stewart, Senior Principal with EMC Research Inc. will present the results of Redmond's annual community survey. It was a survey of residents 18+ in Redmond, WA, and a postcard-to-web survey with a phone option. The survey was conducted from March 27 - April 28, 2025, margin of Error +4.2 percentage points. The survey was provided in English, Spanish, Chinese, and Hindi.

July 8, 2025 - EMC presents final survey results to Council and results are shared with the community and posted on redmond.gov

Outreach Methods and Results: Postcard invitations to participate in the annual community survey were mailed to about 16,000 Redmond households in March 2025, and then follow up contact was made to ensure a statistically valid representation of Redmond was achieved. The citywide online survey was promoted through enews, social media, emails, and the city website.
