REDMOND CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REPEALING THE REDMOND WATER SYSTEM PLAN AND REPLACING IT WITH AN UPDATED PLAN AS PART OF A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN PERIODIC UPDATE, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Washington Administrative Code 246-290-100 requires development of a Water System Plan that demonstrates how a community public water system will address and fund present and future water needs for at least a 20-year planning period; and

WHEREAS, the Growth Management Act (GMA) requires that comprehensive plans and development regulations shall be subject to continuing evaluation and review; and

WHEREAS, the GMA requires that Redmond complete a periodic update of its comprehensive plan by December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Water System Plan is adopted by reference into the Redmond Comprehensive Plan to fulfill GMA planning requirements for capital facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond last completed a periodic update on December 6, 2011, Ord. No. 2638; and

WHEREAS, the Redmond Comprehensive Plan has been amended several times through annual docket processes since 2011; and WHEREAS, the City began the work of updating the Redmond Comprehensive Plan in late 2020 and refers to the update as Redmond 2050; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of updating the Comprehensive Plan is to extend the planning horizon from 2030 to 2050; to incorporate the themes of equity and inclusion, sustainability, and resilience; to reflect changes in the GMA, regional, and countywide planning documents since 2011; and to reflect City actions or studies since the 2011 Comprehensive Plan update; and

WHEREAS, on October 6, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 1538, which established the scope, timeline, and community involvement plan for Redmond 2050; and

WHEREAS, throughout Redmond 2050 the City executed a multifaceted community involvement program to engage Redmond's diverse community, using methods such as a digital city hall lobby, online questionnaires, virtual workshops, in-person workshops, social media, videos, yard signs, utility bill inserts, newsletters, focus groups, contracting with community-based organizations, office hours, tabling at community events, pop-up engagement around the city, translating materials, a community advisory committee, a technical advisory committee, and attending board and commission meetings; and WHEREAS, the City of Redmond issued a determination of nonsignificance for the Water System Plan on August 1, 2023, under the State Environmental Policy Act; and

WHEREAS, state agencies were sent 60-day notices of Redmond's proposed Water System Plan on September 11, 2024; and

WHEREAS, from September 13, 2023 to July 24, 2024, the Planning Commission conducted study sessions and held a public hearing for the Water System Plan and subsequently transmitted a recommendation to the City Council for consideration; and

WHEREAS, from September 3, 2024, to September 24, 2024, the City Council received a staff report and held study sessions to study the Planning Commission's recommendation; and

WHEREAS, having considered the Planning Commission's recommendations and community input, the City Council desires to adopt the 2024 Water System Plan to encourage coordinated and efficient development, and to ensure that adequate facilities and services will be available as development occurs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.Section 2.Findings and Conclusions. The City Councilhereby adopts the findings and conclusions contained in the

associated Planning commission Report, including all related attachments and exhibits, City file no. LAND-2024-00118.

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Water System Plan Repealed</u>. The Redmond Water System Plan, as adopted in Ord. No. 2643 on December 6, 2011, and as subsequently amended, is repealed.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Water System Plan Adopted</u>. The Redmond Water System Plan is adopted as shown in Exhibit 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Preparation of Final Water System Plan</u> <u>Document.</u> The Administration is directed to complete preparation of the final Water System Plan document, including updates to numbering; correction of any typographical errors; minor editorial revisions; inclusion of appropriate graphics and illustrations; and general formatting.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance.

<u>Section 7.</u> <u>Effective date.</u> This ordinance shall become effective five days after its publication, or publication of a

summary thereof, in the City's official newspaper, or as otherwise provided by law.
