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13K residents served



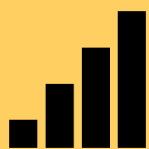
15K people received vaccines

## Community Investment

### \$2.67M

- Funding to 47 agencies, including 74 programs
- **9** of 47 funded agencies are BIPOC led and focused
- \$500K in COVID-response funding
- Of operational grants, 41% support homeless and housing services and 20% support physical and emotional well-being of residents
- \$300K to help with Together Center campus redevelopment project
