A Special Meeting of the Redmond City Council was called to order by Mayor Marchione at 7:00 p.m. in the Redmond City Hall Council Chambers. Council members present and establishing a quorum were: Anderson, Birney, Carson, Fields, Margeson, Myers, and Padhye.

**NEW BUSINESS**

A. AM No. 19-197: Acquisition and/or Condemnation of Property for the NE-70th Street Betterments Project

1. Ordinance No. 2993: An Ordinance Providing for the Acquisition, Condemnation, Appropriation, and Taking of Permanent Real Property Rights in Order to Construct an Additional Northbound Left Turn Lane on Redmond Way to NE 70th Street, as Part of CIP Project No. 163 (Budget No. 20021918); Providing that the Entire Cost Hereof Shall be Paid from Available Funds; and Directing the City Attorney to Prosecute the Appropriate Action and Proceedings in the Manner Provided by Law for Said Condemnation

Mayor Marchione read Ordinance No. 2993 into the record.

Mr. Terry Marpert, Senior Planner, stated that this was discussed during an Executive Session on November 19, 2019, and provided additional details regarding the third parcel.

There was no one wishing to address the Council on this item.

MOTION: Councilmember Birney moved to approve AM No. 19-197 and adopt Ordinance No. 2993. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Margeson.

VOTE: The motion passed with Councilmember Fields in opposition. (6 - 1)


Council President Birney thanked Mayor Marchione for the legacy he is leaving for the City and presented him with a gift from the Council.
