
Cascade Overview

- Regional wholesale water supplier to 7 members.
- Governed by Board of Directors
- Mission is to secure long-term water supply for members
- Purchases water from Seattle
- Redmond purchases 60% drinking water is thought CWA.



Proposed 2025 Operating Budget

2025 Operating Budget: \$49.6M




Proposed 3.5% increase to Member Charges

Tacoma Cascade Pipeline is categorized as an operating expense for 2025-2026. Once Design and Construction is underway, these costs will be capitalized and shown in the CIP.



Cascade Charges based on Member Demands


Historical Redmond Demand

Overall Cascade Change	3.5%	3.5%






