Redmond Climate Commitment Act-Funded Projects

Redmond programs funded by CCA dollars include:

• Transportation

- \$250,000 for electric fire engine charging infrastructure (contingent on the CCA vote in November). Funding from the WA supplemental transportation budget.
- \$750,000 appropriated for this biennium (contingent on CCA vote in November) for the 148th Ave NE Bicycle and Pedestrian Overpass Project from Move Ahead Washington. \$8M total award.

Energy

- \$3.1M award to Energy Smart Eastside (split between 6 cities \$297K to Redmond) from the <u>Department of Commerce Home Electrification and Appliance Rebates Program</u>
- \$850K award from Puget Sound Energy for Energy Smart Eastside Boost Program (split between 5 cities \$187K to Redmond). These are pass through CCA funds.
- \$1.5M award (not announced) to Energy Smart Eastside (split between 6 cities \$285K to Redmond) from the <u>Department of Commerce Adult Family Homes Home</u>
 <u>Electrification and Appliance Rebate Program</u>
- \$100,000 for solar and energy storage feasibility study from the <u>Department of Commerce Solar Plus Storage Program</u>

Climate Resilience and Mitigation Planning

• \$350,000 for HB 1181 implementation from the <u>Department of Commerce Climate</u> <u>Planning Grant Program</u>
