What is a Housing Needs Assessment?

- **Inventory of existing conditions**
 - Workforce
 - Cost burden
 - Demographics
- **Evaluates unmet housing needs**
 - Current Housing Gaps
 - Future Housing Demand
- **Results:**
 - Informs policies & actions

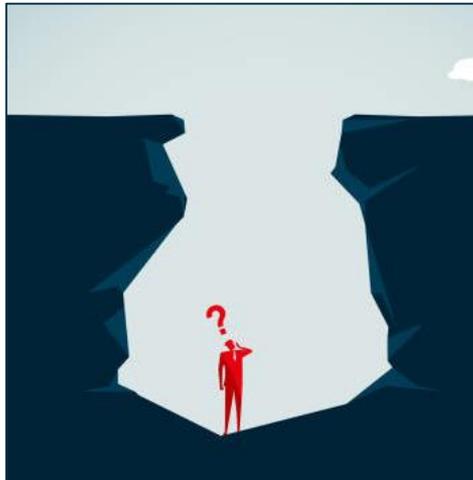

Current Housing Shortage (Ratio Method)

1. Convert Our Population Into Households

- (Redmond Population) divided by (Average Household Size)
= Redmond Households

2. Multiply Redmond Households by 1.14 to find Needed # Housing Units

- 1.14 is the National Housing Ratio
 - (Housing units) divided by (Households)

3. Current Housing Shortage is Equal to:

- [Needed # Housing Units] minus [Current # Housing Units]

Future Housing Demand (More Ratios)

1. Puget Sound Regional Council Forecast Data
 - Macroeconomic Forecast unit of measurement: households
2. Multiply PSRC's Forecasted Households by 1.14 to find our Future Housing Demand # Housing Units
 - 1.14 is the National Housing Ratio
 - (Housing units) divided by (Households)

C. Combine Shortage & Future Demand

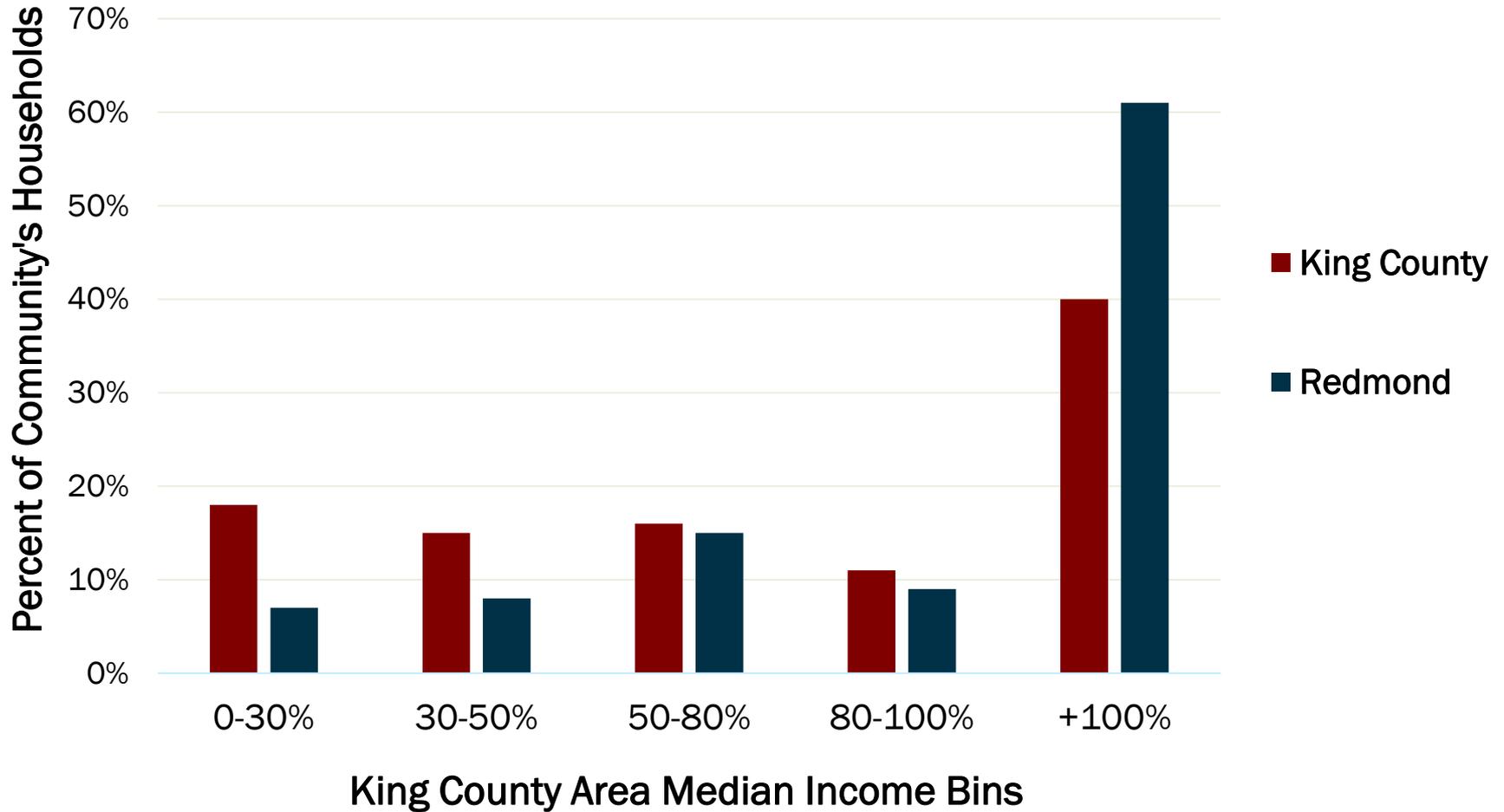
Housing Gap for Redmond in Comparison to Bellevue and Kirkland

City	Current Estimated Underproduction, Units	Future Housing Need, Units	Existing Housing Units (2019, OFM)	Total Units
Redmond	309	8,589	28,619	8,897
Bellevue	1,448	13,173	62,372	14,621
Kirkland	85	5,218	38,980	5,303

- Shortage = Current Shortage
- Need = Future Demand over next X Years
- Shortage + Need = The Total Housing Needed over next X Years

Distribution of Households by Income

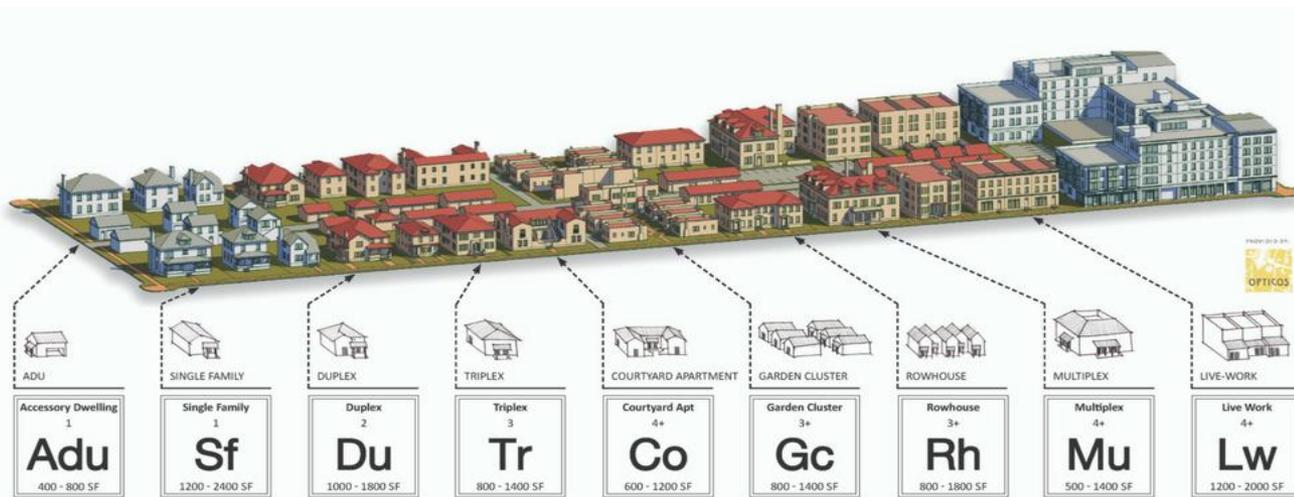


Income to Housing Unit Type Translation
