A request for qualifications was advertised in October 2024. The city received and evaluated seven statements

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of qualifications. David Evans and Associates was ranked as the third best qualified consultant.

OUTCOMES:

The city benefits from having on-call agreements because of the efficiencies and support they provide to a wide variety of projects, programs, planning, and services. On-call agreements do not encumber budgets but are available for project managers to use with approved budget numbers on a task order basis. This provides flexibility with specialized services that are not available using City staff and shortens the turnaround time for using qualified firms for critical work.
