1. Old Firehouse Teen Center Facility Discussion

Department: Parks and Recreation

Action: Informational

Loreen Hamilton, Parks and Recreation Director, was joined by consultants, and reported to the Members of the Council regarding:

- Timeline;
- Assessment;

Discussion ensued regarding: right size; previous evaluation of the building; lead paint; seismic safety; required upgrades; extending useful life; cost overrun for the renovation of the pool; financing; additional studies; exclusions from the 2002 retrofit; current funds; gradually updating the building; accuracy of estimates; reason for closure; future use of building; and next steps.

Carol Helland, Director of Planning and Community Development, Jeff Churchill, Long Range Planning Manager, and Glenn Coil, Senior Planner, reported to the Members of the Council regarding:

 - o Request change to just be mixed use;

 - o Need feedback from Council regarding the possible addition of this item.
