installations for low-income single-family residents earning between <50%-80% AMI. The Boost pilot

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program launched in April 2023, and the first cohort of 25 homes across the five cities are finalizing installation. All six of Redmond's cohort participants installed their heat pumps in December. Lessons learned from the first cohort will inform program updates as ESE prepares to launch a new cohort in Q1 of 2024. Staff will bring a full update on ESE during Q2.

- <u>Fuel Switching Incentive</u>: ESE launched a new marketing campaign called <u>Make the Switch</u> https://www.energysmarteastside.org/maketheswitch to drive program participation. The ESE Fuel Switching program provides an additional market-rate incentive of \$1,500 for middle-income residents (80%-150% AMI) who switch from gas, oil, or wood as a primary heat source. Community members can receive up to \$6,400 off the purchase of a new heat pump when ESE incentives are stacked with federal tax credits and utility incentives. After the campaign, the staff will evaluate campaign metrics and opportunities to increase participation.
- <u>Distributor Incentive</u>: All community members are eligible for a \$500 Mitsubishi rebate and free educational resources.

The Eastside cities of Redmond, Bellevue, Kirkland, Issaquah, and Mercer Island formalized their collaboration in January 2023 with the Eastside Climate Partnership Interlocal Agreement. The agreement allows the partners to share resources for the Energy Smart Eastside Heat Pump program, including staff capacity and future programs supporting joint climate and clean energy goals.

OUTCOMES:

A key strategy to reduce emissions from buildings is to transition to all-electric systems.
