OUTCOMES:

A demonstration or pop-up dog park would address concerns over lack of off-leash dog facilities in or around downtown. The City of Redmond currently does not have an off-leash facility, although many use Marymoor Park's facility. A demonstration project would include public outreach prior and after the implementation to understand use and any issues that should be considered and could include recommendations in the PARCC plan update scheduled to be completed by March 2023.

Community Garden expansion would address the need for more garden plots within the City. This is considered an expansion project as parks already has community garden plots in Juel Park.
