A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE NAME OF THE NEW
COMMUNITY CENTER LOCATED AT 6505 176th AVE NE,
REDMOND AS "REDMOND COMMUNITY CENTER AT
MARYMOOR VILLAGE"

WHEREAS, the City is preparing for the use of the Old Redmond Schoolhouse Community Center (ORSCC) to change to a preschool and the recreation programs and offices at the ORSCC are moving into a new interim location owned by Lake Washington Institute of Technology at 6505 176th Ave NE in the heart of Marymoor Village in Southeast Redmond; and

WHEREAS, the building needs a name that will identify this former college as the new city community center; and

WHEREAS, City of Redmond Resolution No. 874 sets policy and procedure for how recreation centers are named; and

WHEREAS, the City conducted a public process to name the center and the Parks and Trails Commission recommended names to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered the recommendations of the Parks and Trails Commission and broader community then proposed a new name.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Name. After carefully reviewing the
recommendations of the Parks and Trails Commission and the
Community's naming suggestions, the City Council hereby adopts the
name "Redmond Community Center at Marymoor Village" for the city's
new community center.
