Code Proposal for Non-Conforming Fire Damaged Structures and Adult Family Homes

Todd Short, Acting Deputy Fire Chief, reported to the Members of the Committee:

- Addressing rebuilding fire damaged structures with sprinklers;
- Update code to mandate sprinklers;
- Adult family homes only allowed in sprinklered homes;
- Number of units with displaced occupants;
- Fire area in structures; and
- New applications for adult family homes will need to be fire sprinklered.
