What is the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)?



- Mandated per state law to be updated annually
- Six-year transportation planning tool
- Consists of transportation programs and projects that:
 - Support current City transportation priorities and goals
 - Have been identified in adopted planning documents
 - Have external funding commitments like grants or partner contributions
- Not an official financial document



The TIP as a resource

- The annual TIP update enables the Mayor and the City Council a way to review work that has been accomplished as well as assess current and future transportation needs.
- A significant purpose of the TIP is that local projects must be included to be eligible for state and federal grant programs.

Highlight of TIP Changes

- **Completed Projects:** Projects in last year's TIP that have been completed or will be considered complete by 2024 will be removed.
