Per suggestions made at the Study Session on November 9 and the Committee of the Whole meeting on November 23, several changes were made to the Community Strategic Plan, including:

- Added narrative on how the plan was developed
- Added hyperlinks to other plans referenced in the document
- Added another metric for the Environmental Sustainability initiative
- Added Council's 2020 Climate Emergency Declaration to the objective under Environmental Sustainability and provided link to the original document
- Added alignment to the new bus routes to the Infrastructure action on bike and pedestrian safety

As discussed, the Community Strategic Plan is a living document. Staff will update the Council every six-months on the progress made toward the goals and action plans described in the document.
