CANDIDATE INTERVIEWS - HUMAN SERVICES COMMISSION


Alaric Bien, Senior Planner, introduced the Human Services Commission candidates: Sabrina Sevilla and Sonya Lawson-Salmasi.


Candidates spoke regarding their backgrounds and interest in the committee.
