Community Garden & Dog Park Updates

Overview

The Community Garden Expansion and Pop-Up Dog Parks were implemented to meet growing community needs. Both initiatives were identified in the 2017 and 2022 PARCC Plans, which were prioritized with funding in the 2023-2024 budget. Significant community input was gathered through surveys at Derby Days, questionnaires on the Let's Connect page for dog parks, and through staff interactions with community members. These successful programs proved to be positive additions to the Redmond parks system.

- 2023 Juel Park garden expansion
- Total 50 (added 20 new plots)
- 5 accessible raised beds
- Anderson Park new installment
- Design and procurement of materials now
- Installed by growing season 2025

Dog Parks

- 2023 Luke McRedmond pop-up park
 - Repurposed unused sports field fencing for cost savings
 - Enough budget remaining for two locations in 2024
- 2024 Luke McRedmond and Hartman Park pop-up dog parks
 - Locations based on community feedback and outreach
- 2025-2026 Proposed permanent dog park
