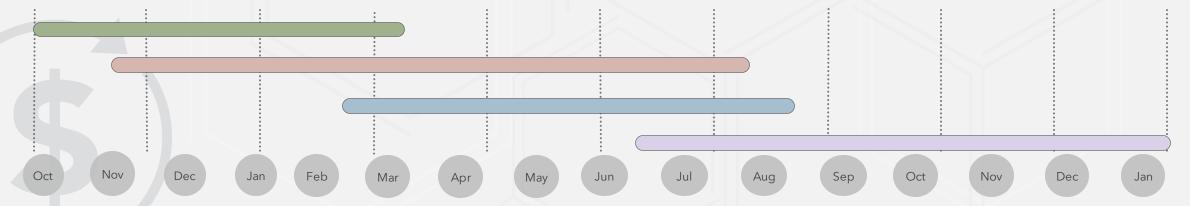

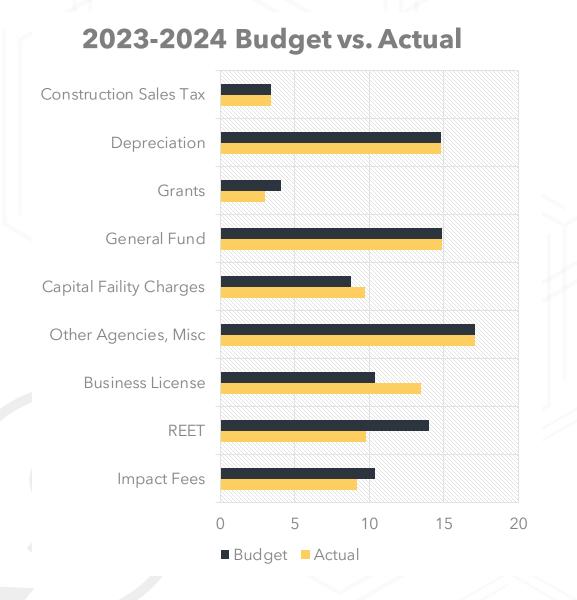

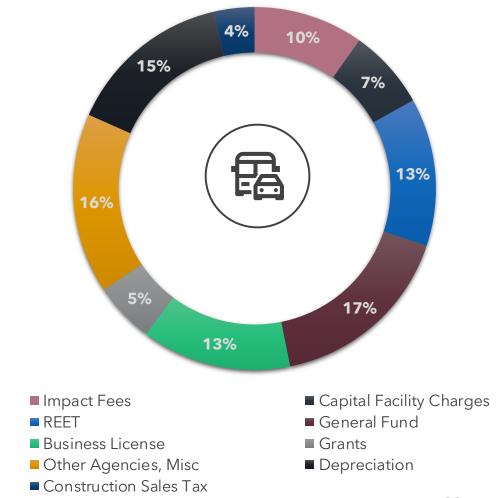

### **Capital Investment Program - Revenue Forecast**

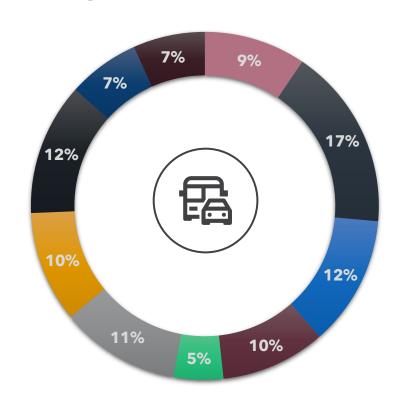


#### Preliminary 2025-2030 - \$330.1M

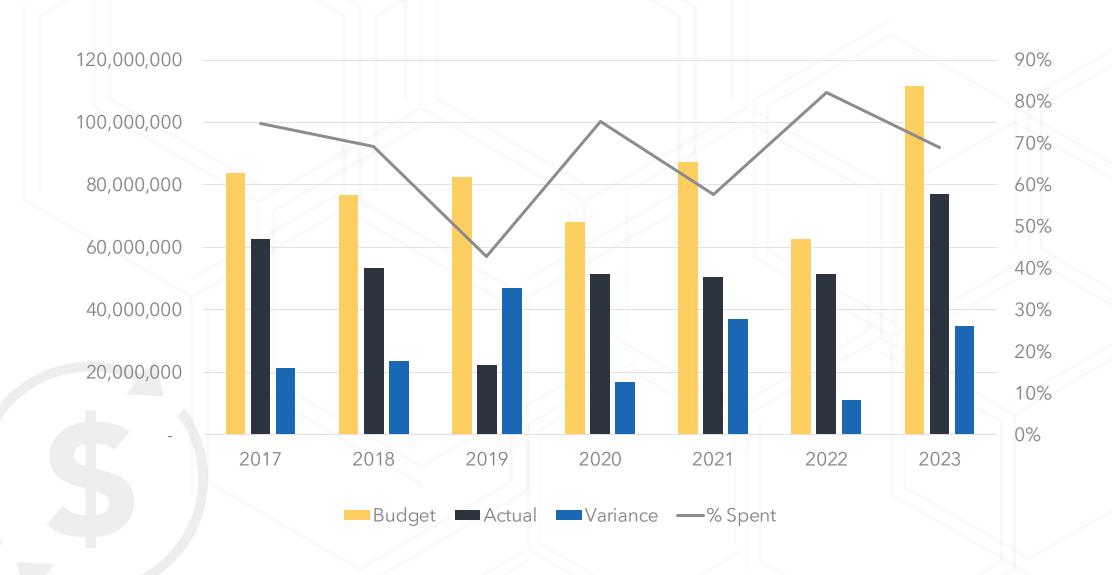

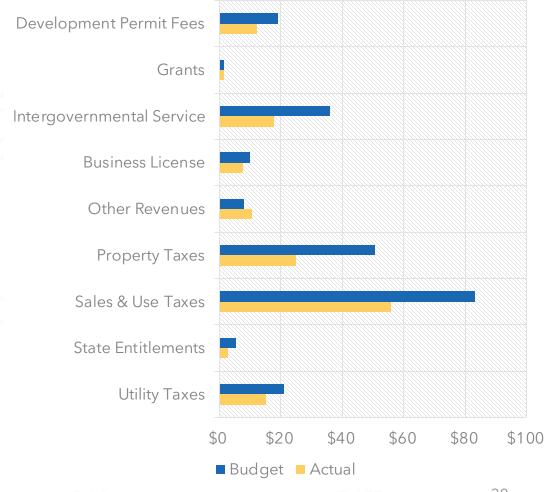

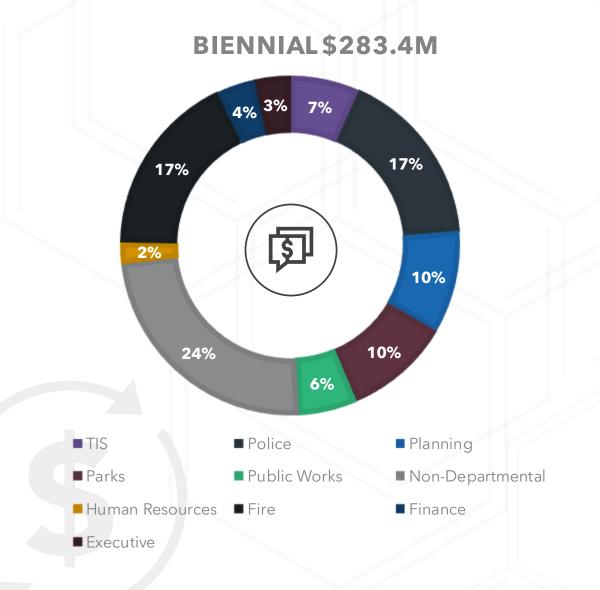
#### General Fund Revenue - 1st Quarter 2024



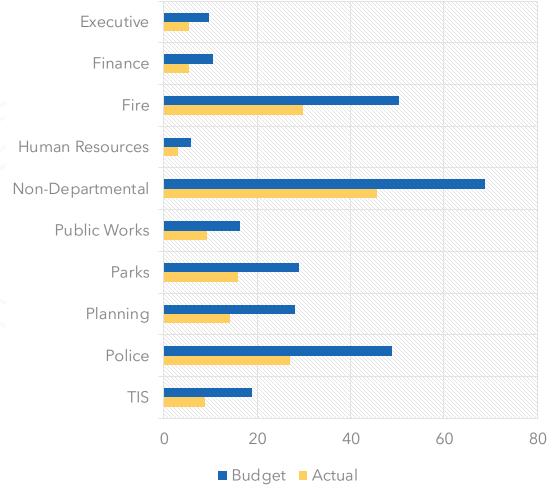
#### **Budget vs Actual**
