C DEFINITIONS

Critical Aquifer Recharge Areas. Areas, defined under the provisions of the Growth Management Act (RCW Chapter 36.70A), where an aquifer that is a source of drinking water is both highly susceptible and vulnerable to contamination. Areas with a high susceptibility to groundwater contamination occur where an aquifer is used as a drinking water source and a combination of the following occur(s): permeable soils, permeable surficial geology, and/or groundwater close to the ground surface as areas with a critical recharging effect on aquifers used for potable water.

R DEFINITIONS

Reclaimed Water. Non-potable water derived from domestic and/or industrial wastewater.

S DEFINITIONS

Significant Groundwater Hazard. A condition in which there is a reasonable probability of release of a hazardous material or deleterious substance, and the material or substance is or can be transferred to a liquid phase that is mobile in both soils and groundwater. that, if reached groundwater, would degrade, alter or form part of a process of degradation or alteration of the groundwater quality so that it becomes or is likely to become harmful for consumption.

W DEFINITIONS

Wrecked Vehicle. A vehicle damaged to the extent that there is high probability of fluid releases.
