

# **Environmental Impact Statement** (EIS) Fundamentals



- A disclosure document that ensures environmental information is considered in decision-making
  - What are the likely impacts of this decision?
  - What measures can we take to mitigate the impacts?
  - What impacts are unavoidable?
- Compares alternatives
- Informs, but does not direct, decision-making
- Governed by chapter 43.21C RCW



- Unavoidable impacts







- Tools for comparing alternatives will include maps, charts, and tables





The preferred growth alternative may be a blend of the alternatives that were evaluated



## **DEIS Community Engagement**

- Wide distribution as required by law
- 45-day comment period as permitted by law (min. 30 days)
- Report cards will summarize alternatives and how they perform
- Variety of engagement opportunities
  - Online
  - Small-group
  - 1:1
- Focused outreach to those historically excluded or underrepresented in environmental review
