ANTICIPATED RESULT IF NOT APPROVED:

This contract will provide approximately \$9.5 million dollars of revenue to the City for 2023, with cost of living escalators over the next five years, to fully cover all City of Redmond costs associated with the provision of services. However, if not approved, the City of Redmond would need to absorb 40 FTEs at the conclusion of the current KCFD34 contract term.
