I. PURPOSE For Info Only Potential Agenda Item Scheduled for Council Action

Seek approval to go to the Council Meeting on September 4, 2018, to accept new transportation revenues.

II. RECOMMENDATION

Approve new revenue from the Puget Sound Regional Council and from Sound Transit for transportation projects, including:

- Puget Sound Regional Council
 - o 152nd Avenue Main Street Construction, \$4,250,000
 - o 40th Street Shared Use Path Construction, \$1,200,000
 - o 90th Street Preservation Design and Construction, \$1,400,000
- Sound Transit
 - o 152nd Avenue & 24th Street Southbound Right Turn Lane, \$1,338,822

IV. <u>DESCRIPTION/BACKGROUND</u>

Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC)

The PSRC Executive Committee recently authorized distribution of grant revenue from the years 2021 and 2022 to the three projects listed above. Council has previously supported these projects through authorization of:

- Design contracts for the 152nd Avenue Main Street
- 2018-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (identifies all three projects)

Sound Transit

Sound Transit has approved a financial contribution to Redmond's 152nd Avenue Main Street project to fulfill the East Link Record of Decision obligation to implement a southbound right turn lane at the intersection of 152nd Avenue and 24th Street. This

contribution to Redmond is an effective method to advance the improvement as it is already included in the scope of Redmond's 152nd Avenue Main Street project.

V. <u>TIME CONSTRAINTS</u>

Time Constraint

The Sound Transit Capital Committee approved revenue for 152nd Avenue in April 2018. Sound Transit is interested in executing the agreement in a timely manner.
