SUBJECT: Resolution to Set Public Hearing Date for Right of Way Vacation – Portion

of NE 102nd Street immediately East of Willows Road

II. <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

This item is to inform the Committee that Staff will recommend a resolution be approved that will set a hearing date for a right of way vacation – NE 102nd Street west of Willows Road. The Resolution will come before Council in early 2019.

IV. <u>DESCRIPTION/BACKGROUND</u>

The Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 35.79.010 establishes the process for which street rights of way are vacated. The City Clerk has received a petition document and supporting information petitioning the legislative authority of the City to vacate a portion of NE 102nd Street being east of Willows Road, more specifically east of the railbanked rail corridor within the Willows Run Golf Course. The City Clerk has found the petition, submitted October 3, 2018, meets the statutory requirement for a vacation request and the legislative authority of the City may now establish by resolution a time the petition will be heard by the legislative authority. The hearing date that will be set must occur not more than 60 days nor less than 20 days after the passage of the resolution.

Staff will review future meeting dates and propose in the resolution a public hearing date appropriate to meet the time criteria for the hearing, as well as, address all posting and notification requirements.

It is anticipated that Staff will request Council's approval to vacate and surplus the right of way area concurrently with the public hearing. A memorandum will include staff's recommendations, alternatives and fiscal considerations specific the vacation of this segment of right of way.
