SURPLUS PROPERTY RESOLUTION

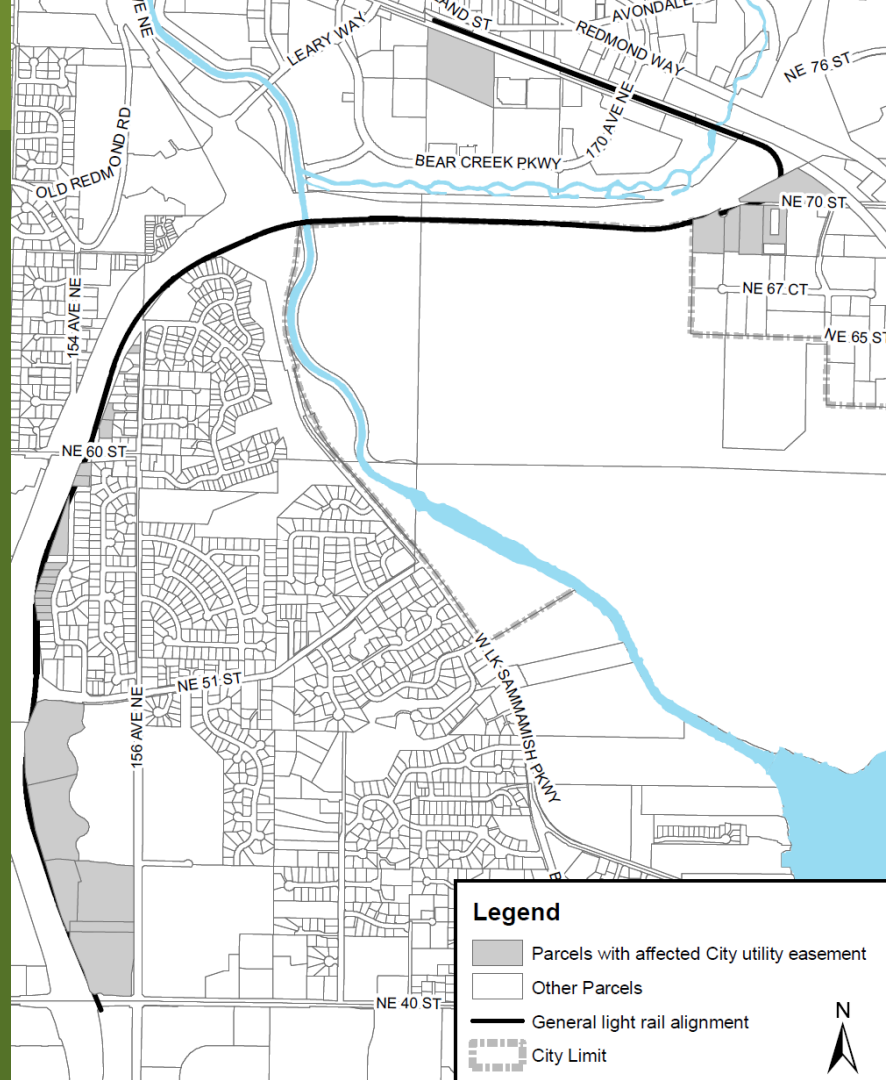
- ST needs City-owned property for light rail extension
- Staff recommends:
 - Holding public hearing on 6/18
 - Approve surplus property resolution on 6/18

UTILITY PROPERTY

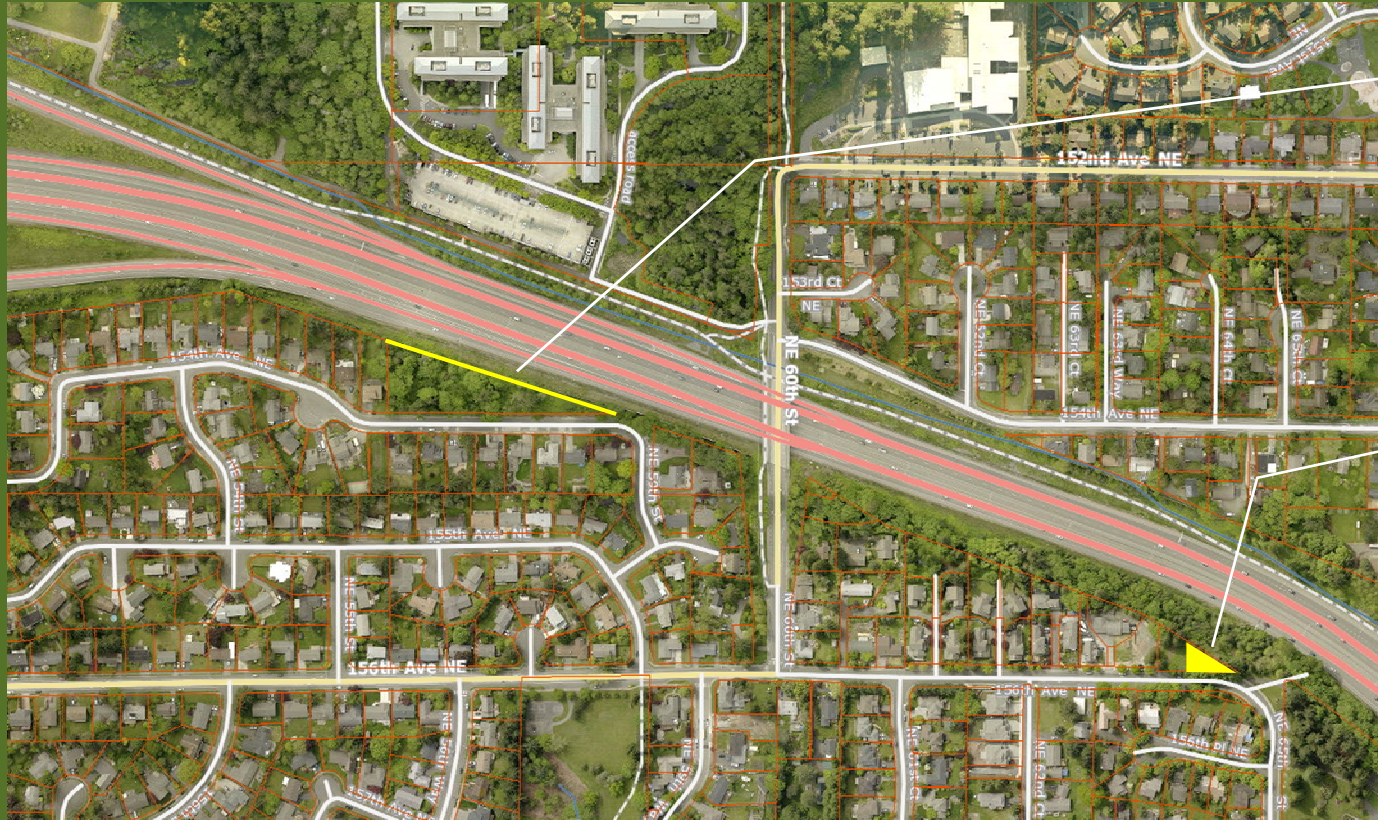
General location of new,

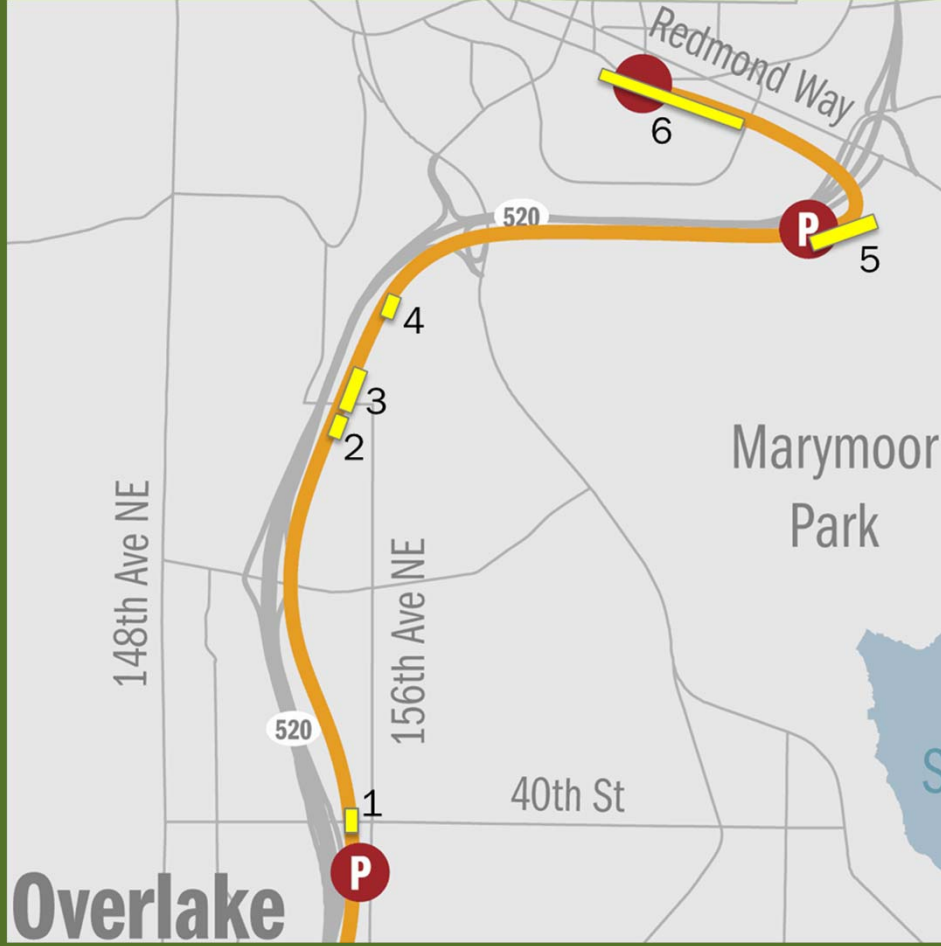
TRANSIT WAY AGREEMENT

- Gives ST right to operate light rail in City rights-of-way
- Staff recommends: approving agreement at July 16 meeting

TRANSIT WAY AGREEMENT

1. Allows ST to operate light rail in City rights-of-way
2. Commits City to minimizing impact to light rail operations when working in ROW
3. Commits ST to operating light rail in accordance with all applicable laws, regulations
4. Duration is for as long as transit way is used for public transportation purposes

TRANSIT WAY AGREEMENT



No at-grade street crossings

CONSTRUCTION SERVICES AGREEMENT

- Governs final design, construction of City “betterments”
- Staff recommends: approving agreement at July 16 meeting
- Study session June 11 if needed



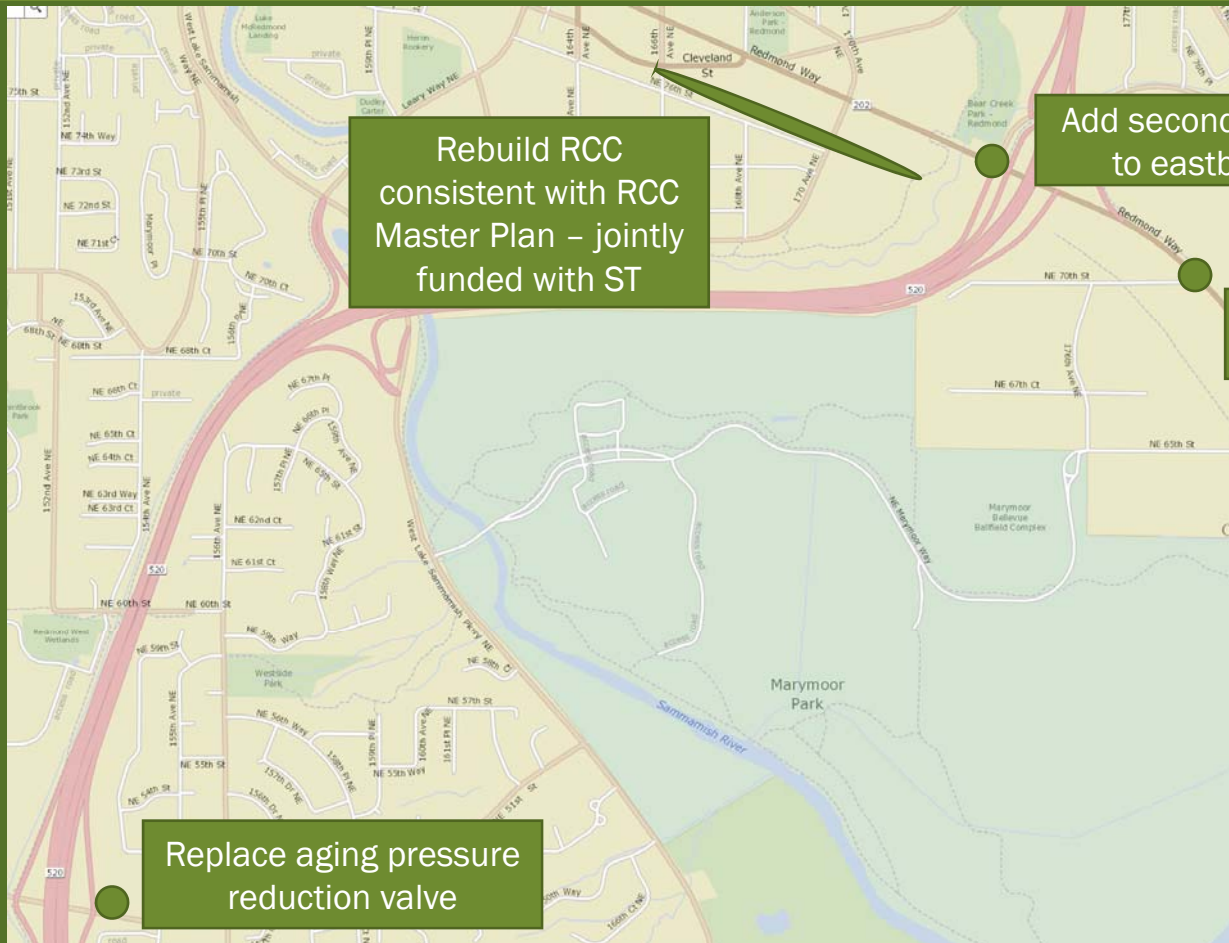
CONSTRUCTION SERVICES AGREEMENT

Four betterments:

1. 51st St. Pressure Reduction Valve
2. 70th St.-Redmond Way Intersection Improvements
3. 76th St.-Redmond Way Intersection Improvements
4. Redmond Central Connector (RC)C Improvements



CONSTRUCTION SERVICES AGREEMENT



Rebuild RCC
consistent with RCC
Master Plan – jointly
funded with ST

Add second left-turn lane
to eastbound 76th

Add second left-turn lane
to westbound 70th

Replace aging pressure
reduction valve

CONSTRUCTION SERVICES AGREEMENT

- Scope of work and changes to scope
- Roles and responsibilities
- Funding
- Acceptance and ownership of betterments
- Termination of agreement
