<u>Issue</u>

Designation of essential vs. non-essential employees

Decision

Essential personnel were designated by Department Directors. HR is clarifying definition of essential vs. non-essential.



<u>Issue</u>

Abandoned vehicles

 Current policy is to utilize private towing to impound at owner's expense

Decision

City Attorney approved the practice of towing vehicles to City parking lot during incident



<u>Issue</u>

Use of paid leave

Decision

- Current policy changed to match pay policy during City closures
- Directors given discretion to determine pay status for essential employees unable to report



<u>Issue</u>

Pay for full day

City closing at 1300 hrs

Decision

Employees paid for full day



<u>Issue</u>

Use of purchasing card (ProCard) for food and emergency housing for employees

Decision

Policies on purchase of food outside of a meeting environment and for emergency housing of employees suspended until after incident
