IV. DESCRIPTION/BACKGROUND

The Willows Road culvert replacement project will replace an undersized, fish barrier culvert on Willows Creek with a 12-foot wide by 85-foot long concrete culvert. The project is part of the Willows Road Corridor project that also includes laying utilities, installing a pedestrian crossing, and rehabilitating 1.9 miles of Willows Road asphalt.

The \$400,000 BAFBRB grant will help pay for construction costs associated with the installation of the new culvert. Remaining costs of the project will be paid for by stormwater CIP budget, and a secured \$175,000 Flood Reduction Grant from King County Flood Control District (approved by Council 11/20/18). The construction target is 2020.

A. Analysis

Council approval will allow the project to accept funding from State of Washington Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO).

V. TIME CONSTRAINTS

The grant expires 6/30/2022, and all expenditures must be prior to this date.
