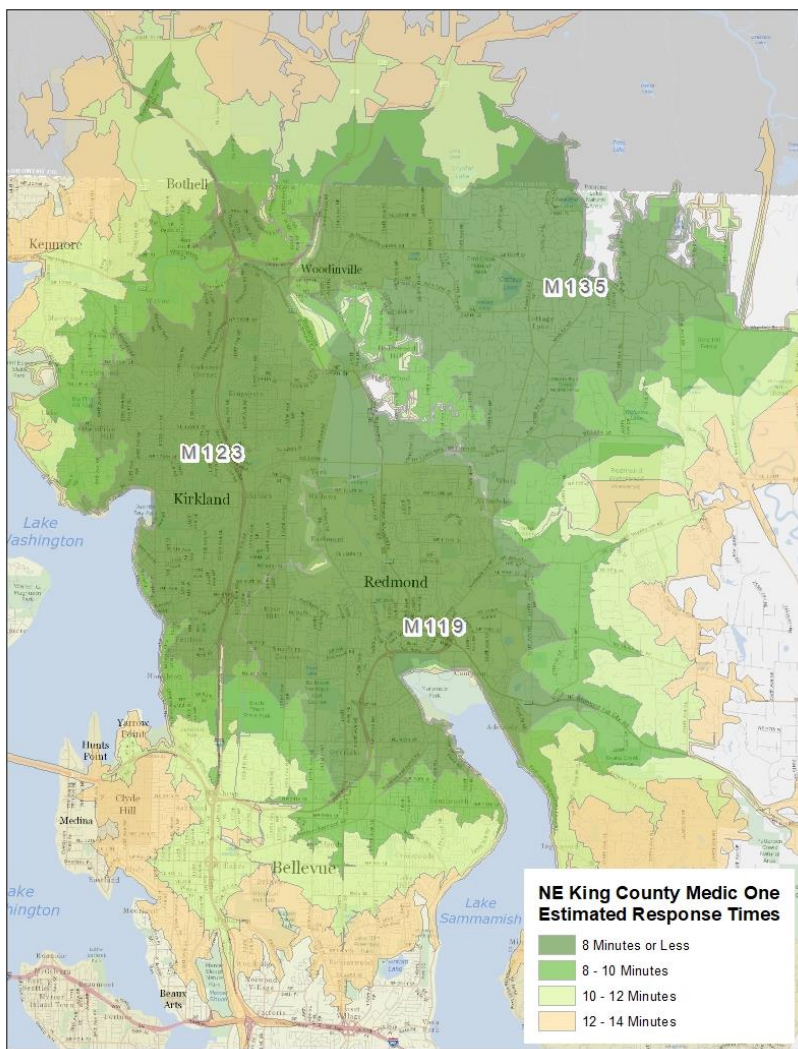

PURPOSE

Renew the King County Emergency Medical Services (KCEMS) Levy ALS Contract

- Redmond has held the contract with KCEMS since 2003 to be the Advanced Life Support (ALS) agency providing EMS services to the North East King County Medic One Consortium
- Redmond provides services to:
 - King County Fire District 27 (Fall City Fire Department)
 - King County Fire District 45 (Duvall Fire Department)
 - Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District
 - City of Kirkland
 - City of Redmond



Locations of Three Medic Units

- M-119 at Fire Station 11 (Redmond)
- M-123 at Evergreen Hospital
- M-135 at Fire Station 35 (Woodinville)



PURPOSE

Renew the King County Emergency Medical Services (KCEMS) Levy ALS Contract

- The current contract expires December 31, 2019 with the 2014-2019 King County Medic One Levy
- New King County Medic One 2020-2025 Levy passed
- New Levy contract for 2020-2025 is being finalized
- New contract to be delivered to provider groups in December 2019 prior to expiration of current contract

CONTRACT CHANGES

Majority of existing contract with minor changes:

- Unit allocations:
 - ALS unit costs
 - ALS program/supervision
 - ALS system allocation
 - ALS equipment
