REDMOND FIRE CODE

 Jurisdictions can amend the code by local ordinances

Amendments cannot be less restrictive than what the state adopts



REGIONAL FIRE MARSHAL'S PROPOSALS

 King County Fire Marshal's collaborate on code proposals for consistency in region

Examples:

- Emergency Responder Radio Systems
- Recreational burn restrictions
- Life safety system testing and maintenance criteria
- Food truck licensing and inspections
