PROJECT PURPOSE

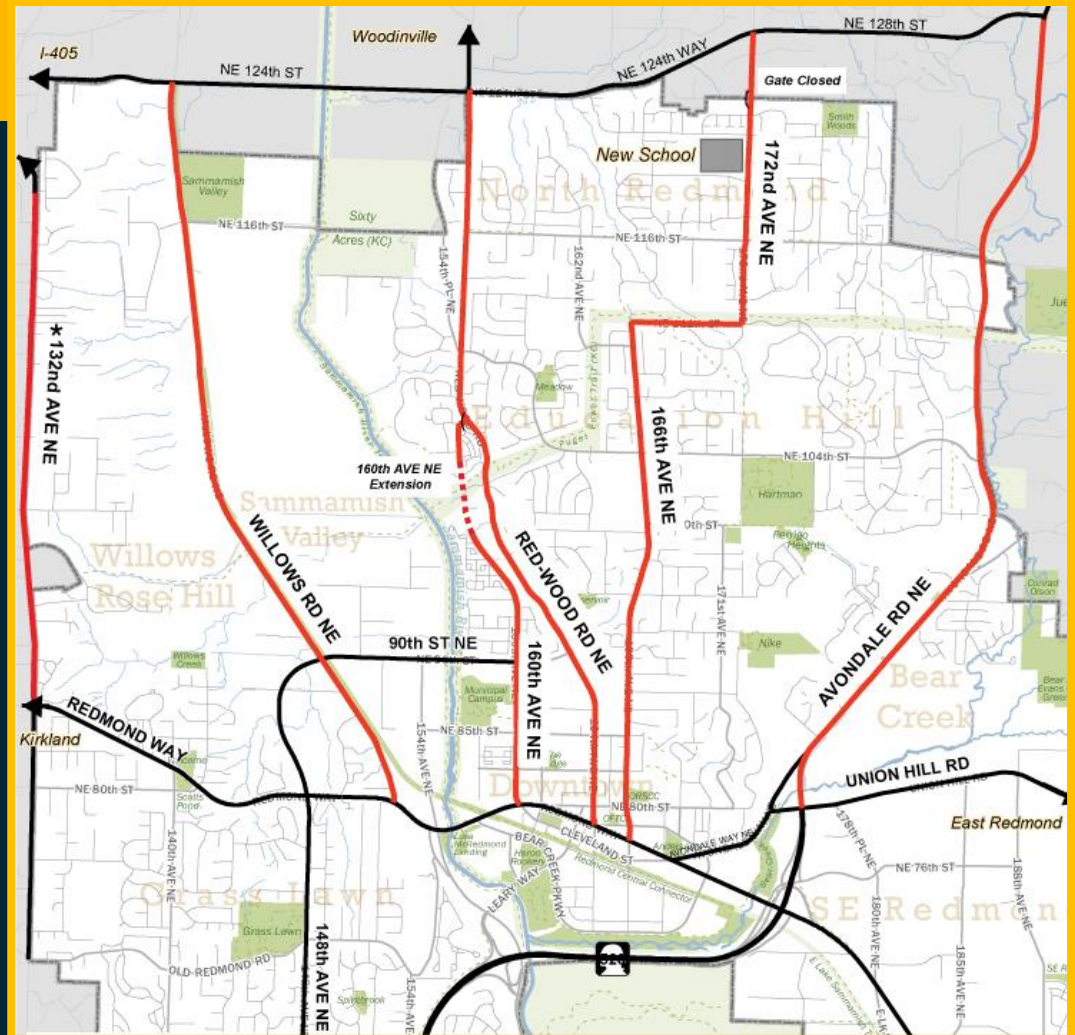
- 1) Analyze City's primary north-south transportation corridors

STUDY AREA

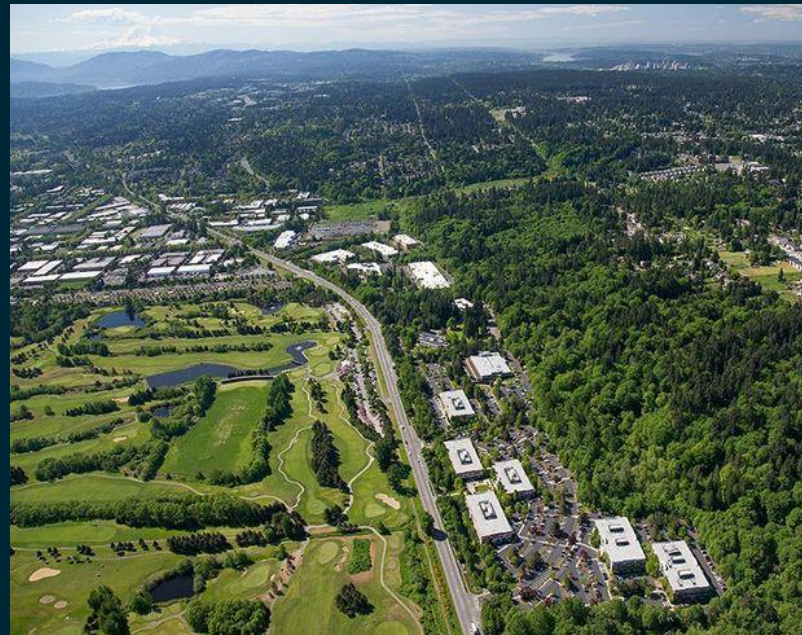
- 1) Willows Rd NE

GOALS

- 1) Identify potential near- and long-term projects
- 2) Formulate criteria to evaluate projects
- 3) Lead community outreach and involvement
- 4) Collaborate with WSDOT, King County, & neighboring communities

PROGRESS TO DATE



- 1) Gathered community feedback on desired outcomes
455 responses to Let's Connect Questionnaire
 - Predictable travel with reliable travel times
 - Improved transit service



- 2) Assessed baseline environmental conditions



- 3) Conducted technical evaluation of project sets by corridor and by timeframe for implementation



- 4) Developed plan for Council engagement and Community involvement
