Supplement Agreement for Construction Management Services

The proposed Supplement Agreement No. 3 with Reid Middleton will cover construction management services for oversight of construction for Stations 14 and 18. The amount of this supplement, with contingency, will not exceed \$151,762. This amount is included in the total project cost of \$4,500,000.
