## CALL TO ORDER AND ESTABLISHMENT OF QUORUM

A Special Meeting of the Redmond City Council was called to order by Mayor Birney at 7:00 p.m. Council members present and establishing a quorum were: Anderson, Carson, Fields, Forsythe, Khan, Kritzer and Padhye.

1.2021-2022 Biennial Budget Deliberations

- MOTION: Councilmember Fields move to fund one more recycling event in the summer with a user fee. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Forsythe.
- VOTE: The motion failed (3-4), with Councilmembers Fields, Forsythe and Khan in support.
- MOTION: Councilmember Forsythe moved to add the topic of the different forms of government to a study session in the first quarter of 2021, topics included in the agenda are: should Redmond voters consider a reclassification from a Code-City to a First Class City and consider a change in our form of government from Mayor-Council to Council-Manager.
- VOTE: The motion passed (5-2), with Councilmembers Carson and Padhye in opposition.

(recess 9:19 p.m., reconvene 9:27 p.m.)

The Chair ruled Councilmember Anderson's proposal out of order.

MOTION: Councilmember Anderson moved to appeal the ruling of the chair. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Fields.

Following Councilmember remarks,

- MOTION: Councilmember Khan called the question. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Forsythe.
- VOTE: The motion passed 7-0.
- VOTE: The motion passed (4-3) with Councilmembers Carson, Padhye and Kritzer in opposition. The ruling of the chair was overturned.

The Councilmember submitted proposals for budget changes was reviewed.
