Purpose

 Seek approval to add 5 FTEs and 1 LTD positions to the Planning and Community Development Department – 6 positions total.

Project Overview

The addition of these staff positions will:

- Increase the City's ability to respond appropriately to increasing development activity by aligning staffing levels with current and anticipated workload demands.
- Allow DSC to consistently meet customer service expectations.
- Support the upcoming Energov transition to HTML.
- Provide necessary time for staff development and training to increase retention.
- Ensure applicants receive more predictable processes and customer service.

These positions are directly supported by revenue.





Community Outreach and Involvement

- The community has asked for more efficiency and less confusion while going through the permitting process.
- We are working to streamline our permitting process by creating a "one-stop shop" Permit Center.
- This effort will require training of staff and allocated time to improve our processes.





Timeline

- August October: Hiring/Onboarding Process
- October: Permitting Software Transition
- Ongoing: Training and Process Improvements
