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OUTCOMES:

The City pays for and SCORE guarantees the City ten (10) beds per day in 2022. This is down from fifteen (15) guaranteed beds per day in 2020 and twelve (12) guaranteed beds per day in 2021. 2022 rates for other jail services, such as specialty beds, are unchanged. A \$35 booking fee which was waived in 2021, has been added for 2022. The reduction in guaranteed beds for 2022 reduces the City's guaranteed financial liability and aligns with projected needs.
