Members of the Council spent time discussing the Library with Mr. Rojas, including areas where he believes library services can be expanded upon to serve the community.

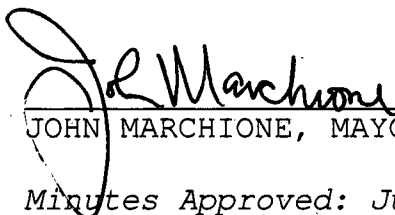
Ms. Carol Helland, Deputy Planning and Community Development Director, introduced Mr. Brian Rich, as a candidate to the Landmark Commission.
