Approval of Project Management Services Agreement, Supplement No. 1, Increasing the Total Project Budget from \$3,434,500 to \$4,500,000, for Design and Construction for King County Fire Protection District No. 34, Fire Station Nos 14 and 18 Seismic Upgrades

Mr. Joe O'Leary, Senior Engineer, reported to the Members of the Committee: increase in cost for the project; approved by the Fire District No. 34; and this item is requested to go forward for Council action on November 17, 2020, on the Consent Agenda.
