TITLE: Approval of the Lake Washington School District 2023-2024 School Community Resource Officer Contract Agreement OVERVIEW STATEMENT: Staff is seeking Council's approval to re-new the interlocal agreement between the City of Redmond and the Lake Washington School District (LWSD) for police services provided during the 2023-2024 school year. At the study session on July 25, 2023, Council received an overview of the status of the School Resource Officer program and desire of the LWSD to continue having the support and commitment of the police department. RPD is committed to further the long-standing partnership between LWSD and the Redmond Police Department. Upon careful consideration, review an input from Police staff and Council, the district moved forward with an MOU for the 2023-2024 school year and changed what was once named School Resource Officer to Community Resource Officer.
