State law requires that each city, proposing amendments to their comprehensive plan, establish a public participation program identifying procedures for early and continuous public involvement in the development and amendment of comprehensive land use plans and development regulations implementing such plans. The public participation program should inform the public of when to comment on proposed changes to the plan, identify the scope and timeline for the review and identify dates for anticipated legislative action. Notice of updates must be provided in accordance with RCW 36.70A.035. In addition to the published notice of this resolution, scope, timeline, and Community Involvement Plan, staff will be posting all documents and updates to the Redmond 2050 project page at www.Redmond.gov/Redmond2050 http://www.Redmond.gov/Redmond2050 .
