OVERVIEW STATEMENT:

A Regional Coalition for Housing (ARCH) was created in 1992 through an interlocal agreement of several city governments and King County to address housing needs in East King County; it currently has 16 member jurisdictions. The ARCH Executive Board reviews funding requests received from non-profit housing providers every fall for projects related to affordable housing. The ARCH Executive Board provides recommendations to member Councils for funding early the following year. These recommendations must be approved by member Councils. This process is conducted annually.

City Council is requested to take the following action:

Adopt a resolution (attached) to authorize allocation of City funds to A Regional Coalition for Housing (ARCH) to finance affordable housing projects for East King County communities per the 2020 Housing Trust Fund (HTF) Recommendations.

The March 2, 2021 **staff report** will include a presentation on the proposed ARCH Housing Trust Fund Recommendations by a representative of ARCH.

OUTCOMES:

After careful deliberation, the ARCH Executive Board concurred with the recommendations of the ARCH Citizen Advisory Board (CAB), and is recommending funding of \$5,000,000 for three projects, including one project that received a partial award last year.

1. Plymouth Housing Group/Horizon Housing Eastgate Permanent Supportive Housing

a. Funding Request for Redmond: \$50,800

b. Affordable Units: 92

2. Imagine Housing Samma Senior Apartments

a. Funding Request for Redmond: \$50,800

b. Affordable Units: 76

3. Inland Group/Horizon Housing Totem Lake Development

a. Funding Request for Redmond: \$406,700

b. Affordable Units: 299
