Work Plan Adjustment for Climate Emergency Topic

OVERVIEW STATEMENT:

During the September 7, 2021, Business Meeting, Council voted to add climate emergency as a standing agenda topic on the Public Safety Committee of the Whole meeting. Council raised two items for further discussion, including:

- 1. Structural changes necessary to add sustainability to the Public Safety Committee Work Plan. The current Work Plan is included as Attachment A. Any changes to the Work Plan through the remainder of the year must be approved by the Committee Chair and should be coordinated with the Chief of Police and Fire Chief. Committee structures, including naming and work plans, will be reevaluated and discussed at the October 12, 2021 Study Session.
- 2. Sustainability work plan topics to guide future agendas. A summary of topics discussed by Council is included in Attachment B.
