OVERVIEW STATEMENT:

City Council previously adopted by reference all RCW's listed in 9.46.010, including RCW 9.91.025 Unlawful Bus Conduct. (<u>RCW 9.91.025</u>: <u>Unlawful transit conduct</u>. (<u>wa.gov</u>) <<u>https://apps.leg.wa.gov/RCW/default.aspx?cite=9.91.025</u>)</u> The intent of this proposal is to amend the language in RMC 9.46.010 so that it continues to mirror the listed RCW'S and eliminate the need to make changes going forward by adopting all current versions and future amendments. Additionally, the change updates RCW 9.91.025 Unlawful Bus Conduct to the current title of Unlawful Transit Conduct. The proposed ordinance updates and modernizes the State statues that Council previously incorporated by reference
