  - --Created a "Let's Connect Redmond" webpage to solicit and gather input from stakeholders.

  - --Announced release of the draft plan using the City's EnivroNews, newsletter. This was followed-up with 2 Facebook announcements space a week apart.
  - --Held three sets of "Office Hours" allowing stakeholders to directly contact the plan's project manager.
  - --Held an on-line stakeholders meeting May 30, 2021.
